Please do not use translucent plastic or tarps wrapped around poles. Make sure to start preparing now so your homes are winter ready. Inspect your hot water tank. Caulk around windows and doors. Reverse ceiling fans to push the warm air down. Check skirting to make sure that nothing is loose or out of place.

Please turn on your outside light after calling 911. This will help the first responders find your home quicker. Please check the furnace flue for birds' nest and remove them before turning on the furnace for the winter season
