LOCAL ORGANIZATIONS THAT OFFER RECYCLING OR ARE DONATION CENTERS

Although Columbia Park does not have a recycling program, there are a few places to take materials instead of discarding them. Please consider recycling items instead of trashing them. A few recycling centers are listed below. If you know of other locations, please let us know.

All Saints Church - Located just south of Columbia Park at 7230 Columbia Road, All Saints Church has a dumpster to recycle paper (note it is *paper only*, no cardboard) and a bin to donate used clothing in the rear of the building. Clothing donations benefit the church and community. Paper and clothing may be brought to the church at any time. Clothing must be in a bag and tied closed.

Olmsted Township Recycling - You can recycle aluminum, glass, plastic, paper, and cardboard in a blue recycle bin across from the service building on Old Fitch Road, just north of the railroad tracks. All containers must be empty and rinsed, caps or lids may be replaced. Cardboard must be clean of food waste and flattened. The items must be placed loose in the bin and cannot be left in plastic bags.

The Second Mile Shop - At 1480 Bagley on corner of Bagley Road and Lewis Road, The Second Mile Shop accepts donations of furniture, clothing, and anything that can benefit local families or be sold at the thrift shop. They also have a dumpster for paper and cardboard; all cardboard must be flattened. The store only accepts donations on Thursdays and Saturdays from 10AM to 4PM.
