#### **COLUMBIA PARK ENTRANCE MAKEOVER**

Thank you for your patience as we upgraded the Columbia Road entrance. Installation is complete! We have distributed most of the initial window stickers to activate the gate for residents. If you are one of the 33 who have not received one, please reach out to the gatehouse. We should have additional passes available soon for any resident with a second vehicle.

The Columbia Park staff will begin training on the gate system during the week of November 6th. When we're close to putting the gates into operation, we will train our residents and provide information on how to operate the gates and how your guests can enter the community.

Once the gates are up and running, our wonderful gatehouse attendants will be present 24/7 to ensure a smooth transition. More information will be provided when we get closer to that stage in the process.

If you replace your current vehicle, please be sure to remove the gate sticker that was provided to you as these are quite costly to have produced. If you have trouble removing the sticker, please come by the office. The team is happy to assist!

#### **WINTER PREPARATION**

Please remember to check your heat tape! Heat tape prevents pipes from freezing and will save you a lot of time and aggravation when the temperatures drop.

Residents can now install Visqueen Windbreaks. These windbreaks can remain in place from November 1<sup>st</sup> until April 15<sup>th</sup>. The same design that has been used in the past is the only one that has been approved. Please *do not* use translucent plastic or tarps. Make sure to start preparing now so your homes are winter ready!

Be sure to inspect your hot water tank, check the furnace flue for bird's nests and remove them before turning on the furnace for the season, caulk around windows and doors, reverse ceiling fans to push the warm air down, and check skirting to make sure that nothing is loose or out of place.
