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## FEEDING WILDLIFE IN THE COMMUNITY

With the recent cold temperatures, we've noticed an increase in food being left out for wildlife. While this is well-intended, feeding wild or stray animals can cause issues for both residents and the community.

As a reminder, the Community Guidelines prohibit the feeding of wild or stray animals with the exception of bird feeders which must be at least four feet off the ground. Placing food on the ground is a violation of the Department of Health Ohio Administrative Code. Please avoid attracting wild or stray animals in our community.

## PET OWNER RESPONSIBILITIES

To ensure a safe and enjoyable environment for all residents, we kindly remind pet owners to follow these important community guidelines:

### **Pet Behavior & Supervision:**

- Residents are fully responsible for their pet's behavior. Dangerous, noisy, or unruly animals are not permitted in the community.
- Pets must be leashed and accompanied by a resident at all times when outside.
- Fenced-in enclosures, dog houses, and tying pets outside are strictly prohibited.

### **Noise & Cleanliness:**

- Excessive barking must be controlled to avoid disturbing neighbors.
- Pet waste must be picked up immediately, both on your lot and while walking your pet. Failure to clean up may result in a minimum \$35 removal fee.

### **Stray & Unattended Animals:**

- Animals running loose may be removed by local authorities.
- Community recreation areas are not for pet use. Please be respectful of shared spaces.
