COLUMBIA GAS REPLACEMENT PROJECT

Columbia Gas and their contractor, Miller Pipeline, are continuing their work on the gas line replacement project in Columbia Park. Crews are now installing service lines to the affected homes. Homeowners will be notified by Columbia Gas by a knock on the door, via email or by leaving a notice on your door. Once all the service lines are installed, Columbia Gas will repair and replace any portions of sidewalks, driveways, or landscaping disturbed by their work. The goal is to restore everything as close to its original condition as possible.
